The MOTA museums are conveniently located near the 134 and 110 freeways in Pasadena and Los Angeles.

Heritage Square is located just north of downtown off of the Pasadena (110) at the Avenue 43 exit and also walkable from the Heritage Square Gold Line Stop. Lummis Home and Garden is within walking distance of Heritage Square and The Autry's Historic Southwest Museum - Mt. Washington Campus is slightly further by foot, and also available as the next Pasadena-bound stop of the Gold Line.

The Gamble House and Pasadena Museum of History are located off of the Ventura (134) freeway on either side of Orange Grove at Walnut Avenue. The Los Angeles Police Historical Museum in located south of the 134 freeway; take Figueroa south to York Blvd.

Parking is available on surface streets around each museum and at the Heritage Square Gold Line station. Limited parking is also available next to the main entrance at Heritage Square. Parking is also available in lots next to the Pasadena Museum of History on Walnut St.

SHUTTLES: Museums of the Arroyo Day will have limited shuttle service. The shuttles will stop at all museums except the Pasadena Museum of History.

Shuttles will run between The Gamble House and Los Angeles Police Historical Museum and between the Los Angeles Police Historical Museum and Heritage Square.
